**General Guideline of Professional Fee Structure for  
Clinical Psychologists in Malaysia (2016)**

The Malaysian Society of Clinical Psychology recommends the following guide based on the results of a survey done in 2016:

**1. PSYCHOLOGICAL CONSULTATION/PSYCHOTHERAPY FEE**

(Initial Intake or Follow-up Session)

**a. PRIVATE**

This is a general guideline and the range of fees depend on location and qualification:  
RM150 – RM450 per hour

**b. GOVERNMENT**

Based on fees set by the Ministry of Health (public hospitals) or teaching hospitals' settings.

**2. PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT FEE**

Psychological assessment package can consist of: -

- Pre-assessment consultation
- Single or multiple tests administration
- Assessment report
- Post-assessment feedback to client/family
- Site visits (if required)

**a. PRIVATE**

- i. A general acceptable range of fee does not exceed RM5,000 per package
- ii. Fees are generally charged depending on duration, number of tests, types of test and on a case-by-case basis.
- iii. General Assessment package: RM500 – RM2,000 per package
- iv. Comprehensive Assessment package: RM2,000 – RM5,000 per package

**b. GOVERNMENT**

Based on the fees set by Ministry of Health (public hospitals) or teaching hospitals' settings.

**3. BRIEF PSYCHOLOGICAL REPORT FEE**

Generally, 1-2 pages, non-psychological assessments for referral source: -

**a. PRIVATE**

Ranges from RM100 – RM200 per report

**b. GOVERNMENT**

Based on the fees set Ministry of Health (public hospitals) or teaching hospitals' settings.



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**The Private Healthcare Facilities and Services (Private Hospitals and Other Private Healthcare Facilities) (Amendment) Order 2013 (P.U. (A) 358) states:**

**(o) Psychiatry – Psychotherapy**

<b>Services</b>	<b>Fees per session (RM)</b>
Individual psychotherapy <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Not less than 45 minutes per session</li><li>• Including behavior therapy and hypnotherapy</li></ul>	250
Group psychotherapy per person <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• One hour per group</li><li>• Not less than three patients and not more than eight patients per group</li></ul>	65
Marital therapy per couple <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Not less than 45 minutes per session for a couple together</li></ul>	250
Family therapy per family <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Not less than 30 minutes per session</li><li>• Session includes relevant family interviews</li></ul>	250
Child psychotherapy <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Not less than 30 minutes per session</li><li>• Session includes relevant family interviews</li></ul>	250
Each electroconvulsive therapy (ECT)	315

\*Note: the above are charges by psychiatrists for psychotherapy.

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
